
## Landform Loteria!







**Lotería** is the Spanish word for "lottery." **Lotería** is a Latin game originated in Mexico similar to the game of Bingo here in the United States.

**Directions**: You will be responsible for creating 2 lotería cards based on 2 real landforms. I encourage you to use an electronic device to research. For example, if my landform was a coral reef my card could depict the Great Barrier Reef in Australia.

## **Materials:**

- One sheet on printer paper (folded in half horizontally)
- Colored Pencils, Markers, or Crayons
- Ruler

## **Requirements:**

- A visual for each of the two different landforms represented
- Visual of the landform resembles the actual location (display effort! I know that everyone is not a great artist)
- Longitude and Latitude of the landform location written in the top **left** corner of the card
- Name of the landform written in English at the top **right** corner of the card
- Name of the landform in another language at the bottom of card
- You must also include the country and continent where they are located
